

SUFFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (IPSWICH) (VARIOUS ROADS) (TEMPORARY CLOSURE & SUSPENSION OF ONE-WAY FOR A SPECIAL EVENT) (JULY) ORDER 2019

WHEREAS Suffolk County Council ('the Council') being the highway authority for the roads specified in this Order, is satisfied that traffic on the said roads should be restricted to enable Ipswich Jaffa Running Club (hereinafter referred to as 'the organiser') to hold the Ipswich Twilight 10k Running Race (hereinafter referred to as 'the event').

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council in exercise of its powers under Section 16A(2) and (10) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Road Traffic Regulation (Special Events) Act 1994 and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Order:

1. The provisions of this order will operate as and when required at the discretion of the police and event organisers.

PART I: ROAD CLOSURE

2. Except as provided in Articles 3 or 4, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, a police community support officer or a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle other than a bicycle or any horse to proceed between the hours of 19:00pm and 9.30pm in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall make it unlawful for a person to cause or permit any vehicle or any horse to proceed in the lengths of road referred to in that Article if the vehicle or horse is taking part in the event in an official capacity.
4. (1) Insofar as safe passage permits, nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall make it unlawful for a person to cause any vehicle or any horse to enter or proceed in the length of road referred to in that Article in order to gain access to or egress from premises adjacent to or accessible only from those lengths of road.

(2) Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall make it unlawful for a person to cause or permit any vehicle or any horse to proceed in the lengths of road referred to in that Article if the vehicle or horse:

(i) is to be used for police operational, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;

(ii) cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road and is to be used in an emergency in connection with any of the following operations, namely: the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or on land adjacent to the said lengths of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications system as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;

PART 2:

5. The Ipswich Borough Council (Moving Vehicle Traffic Restrictions) Consolidation Order 2009-MT01 in so far as it imposes measures controlling one-way traffic in Great Coleman Street is suspended for the duration of this Order.

PART 3: CONDITIONS

6. This Order is made on condition that the organiser will:
 - (a) advise all residents and businesses affected by the above measures;
 - (b) keep the local police informed of all proceedings related to the event;
 - (c) indemnify the Council from and against all legal liability in respect of loss, damage, actions, proceedings, suits, claims, demands, costs, damages, liability and expenses in respect of any injury to or death of any person or destruction of or damage to any property (whether movable or immovable) by reason of or arising in any way directly or indirectly from the holding of the event;
 - (d) reinstate and make good to the satisfaction of the Council any damage caused as a result of the holding of the event; and
 - (e) pay to the Council a fee for legal and administration costs as shall be agreed with the Council.
7. Nothing in this Order shall prevent access by vehicles being used for police operational, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
8. This Order shall be operative at 19.00 hours on 26 July 2019 and shall continue in force until 21:30 hours 26 July 2019. It may be cited as the Suffolk County Council (Ipswich) (Various Roads) (Temporary Closure for a Special Event) (July) Order 2019.
